

# NEUSE RIVER DAY PADDLEFEST

## NEUSE RIVER – GLENBURNIE PARK (4 mile) PADDLE

Saturday - May 31<sup>st</sup> 2008  
(FIRST ANNUAL)

**When:** Registration opens 8:30 am

**Where:** Glenburnie Park, New Bern

**Launch Time:** 10:30 a.m.

**Details:** Join paddlers from the Neuse 100 miler and those departing from Cool Springs for a fun filled social paddle to celebrate Neuse River Awareness and support of the Neuse River Foundation. All paddlers departing from Glenburnie Park will travel the Neuse River downstream and alongside New Bern's waterfront. Upon reaching Union Point Park, the flotilla will pause briefly for the noontime "photo- op" in front of the downtown park's gazebo.

Immediately following the photo shoot, paddlers are asked to proceed to the small sand beach area at the end of Pollock Street next to the Galley Store. Help with disembarking and secure boat storage will be found there. All participants are invited to participate in a catered BBQ in the park following.

Transportation will be provided back to your vehicles at scheduled times posted at the take out.

**Provisions:** Dress for the conditions, wear a suitable and CG Approved PFD and bring plenty of water

**Directions to:** Glenburnie Park

From US 70, head north on Glenburnie Road (SR 43) for about 2 miles, turn right on Oaks Rd. and continue another 1/2 mile. Turn left on Glenburnie Drive to end of road. Bear left into park, than turn left at top of the hill. After about 100 yards, turn right and head toward the shelter building. Launch from the beach located just down the hill.
